Leadline. Open to children 7 years and younger as of 12/1/20. To be judged 50% suitability of mount and 50% rider's equitation. Riders not allowed to cross enter into any class where they would be asked to trot.

Pre-Short Stirrup Equitation. Open to riders 10 years and under. Riders not allowed to cross enter into classes where they would be asked to canter or jump.

Working Hunter Open to horses and ponies not entered in pony divisions. Jumps 2'9", 3'.

Short Stirrup Equitation. Riders 12 years and under. . May not enter any classes with fences higher then 18".

Long Stirrup Hunter Open to riders 13 and over. May not enter any classes with fences higher then 18".

Student Equitation. Riders in their 1st or 2nd year of showing at 2′ or higher. Jumps not to exceed 2′. May trot or canter over fences

Schooling Hunter. Open to horses and ponies.

Green Pony Hunter. Open to ponies in their first year of showing over fences, including pleasure and equitation classes over fences at or above 2′ for Sm Ponies, 2′3″ for Med Ponies and 2′6″ for Lg Ponies, ridden by juniors.

Green Hunter. Open to horses in their first or second year of showing over fences at 2'6'' or higher including pleasure and equitation classes as of 12/1/20.

Junior, Pony, Adult Amateur Equitation. Junior riders and Adult Amateur riders. Small ponies to jump 2′, Medium ponies to jump 2′3″, Large Ponies to jump 2′6″ and Horses to jump 2′6″ or 3′ over a course of at least 6 fences.

Equitation on the Flat. Open to Juniors and Adult Amateurs, Adult Amateurs, Juniors 15-17 and juniors 14 and under if entries warrant.

Thoroughbred Hunter. Open to Thoroughbred horses registered with The Jockey Club or eligible to be registered. To jump 2′6″. T.I.P. Pleasure Horse.

Pony Pleasure. Open to Ponies ridden by juniors. Judged the same as Horse Pleasure. **Pony Hunter**. Open to Small Ponies not over 12.2 hands to jump 2′, Medium Ponies over 12.2 but not over 13.2 hands to jump 2′3″ and Large Ponies over 13.2 but not over 14.2 hands to jump 2′6″. Junior riders.

Low Hunter. Open to horses and ponies. Fences set at 2' and 2'3".

Limit Rider Hunter – Open to horses and ponies ridden by juniors/adult amateurs not entered in any classes jumping 2'6" or higher. Riders are not eligible for pony, adult or junior/children's equitation classes. Ponies must be ridden by juniors. Horses and ponies may cross enter into other divisions. Fences 2'3".

Children's/Adult Amateur Hunter. Open to horses ridden by juniors and horses ridden by Adult Amateurs to jump 2′6″ or 3′.

Any 18" hunter divisions horses May not cross enter in divisions jumping over 18" **Any 18" equitation divisions** riders may not cross enter in divisions jumping over 18"
